10 Best Practices for a Successful Campaign

1. Build a team and secure CEO/management support
2. Determine your timeline and start planning at least 2-4 weeks before your kick-off
3. Set your goal
4. Plan your campaign activities
5. Incorporate volunteering into your campaign
6. Promote your campaign to employees (and retirees)
7. Start your campaign with a fun, inclusive kick-off
8. Organize special events and use incentives
9. Recognize leadership donors, first time donors, etc.
10. THANK employees and celebrate success!

Raise extra \$'s

Encourage your most talented to entertain co-workers at a Lip-Sync Contest, Barbecue Cook-Off, Bake Sale or Talent Show.

Share a Story

Invite employees to be videotaped sharing why they have pledged or let them share a personal story regarding the United Way, how they were helped or why they volunteer.

Chalk It Up

THROUGH THE WILSON COUNTY

\$1 PER WEEK provides 11 elderly homebound senior citizens a hot, nutritious meal through the home delivered meals program.

\$2 PER WEEK can shelter someone who is homeless for one night or provide food to someone who is hungry

\$5 PER WEEK can provide two children with a learning environment and recreational experience keeping them safe and off the streets.

\$7 PER WEEK can provide emergency day care for five sick children for one week each, so five teen mothers can go to school.

\$10 PER WEEK sends six children with developmental disabilities to summer day camp where they can swim, sing, snack, participate in arts and crafts and receive a hug every day.

In 1959, the United Fund of Wilson County was organized during a meeting at the Cherry Hotel. The goal for this initial fundraising effort was set at \$79,568.30. Today, the organization we now call the United Way raises more than one-million dollars annually to fund human service agencies for people in need in Wilson County.

FAIR Share Challenge Rules and Regulations

The Grand Prize.

One person will win a \$2,500 cash prize.

1. Who is eligible? Any person who is 18 years or older, with a Social Security number or ITIN number, and who makes a Fair Share contribution to United Way of Wilson County's 2024 Community Investment Campaign to be paid in full by December 31, 2024.

2. Who is not eligible? United Way of Wilson County staff, agency staff and United Way board and committee members.

3. How the drawing works: Weekly drawings will be held beginning October 30 through December 11, 2024. 21 finalists will be selected from Fair Share Givers submitted by each employer's Campaign Coordinator. Each finalist will be asked to complete and return the entry form below, which includes the rules of eligibility, within 3 days to the employer's Campaign Coordinator. The Campaign coordinator will submit the completed entry form after validating the pledge information, to Betty Baker, United Way of Wilson County Assistant Director – asstdir@unitedwayofwilson.org. A total of 21 finalists randomly selected, will move on to the Grand Prize event, held on December 18, 2024 at noon. Finalists must provide the United Way of Wilson County with proof of a Social Security Number or ITIN number prior to the final drawing, and must be present at the final event.

4. Campaign Coordinators will verify social security numbers and Fair Share amounts prior to the final drawing event.

5. Requirements: The winner must provide United Way of Wilson County with their Social Security number or ITIN number in order to win the \$2,500 Grand Prize. United Way of Wilson County will mail the winner an IRS Form 1099. The winner is required to pay all applicable taxes, and must pay his/her pledge in full to United Way of Wilson County by December 31, 2025. The winner grants United Way of Wilson County the use of his/her name and photograph in all communication and publicity materials.
